BioTheRoS Presents Advanced Biofuel Innovations at CEBC 2026 Workshop in Graz

The BioTheRoS project successfully hosted a dedicated workshop at the [8th Central European Biomass Conference \(CEBC\) 2026](#), bringing together researchers, industry leaders, and policy stakeholders to discuss the latest advancements in thermochemical biofuel technologies and sustainable transport fuels.



The workshop focused on emerging developments in **thermochemical biofuel production technologies**, including **pyrolysis** and **gasification**, offering participants insight into both research and industrial practice. Presentations addressed key market trends and sustainability perspectives, drawing on the collective expertise of project partners and international collaborators.



BioTheRos has received funding from the European Union's Horizon Europe research and innovation programme under grant agreement no. 101122212

A defining feature of the event was the **open panel discussion**, which brought together leading voices from across Europe's biofuel sector. Contributors included representatives from multiple **IEA Bioenergy Tasks (33, 34, and 39)**, **ETIP Bioenergy**, and the **ICARUS EU Project**, who exchanged perspectives on research priorities, international cooperation, and the future of advanced transport fuels.



Workshop attendees were also provided with **free access** to the first conference day of CEBC, allowing broader participation in plenary sessions and networking opportunities. A full set of workshop presentations has since been made available for download to support continued engagement and knowledge sharing among stakeholders.

“By bringing together experts from research, industry, and policy circles, the BioTheRoS workshop contributed to a deeper understanding of the role that **thermochemical biofuels** must play in the transition to sustainable energy systems,” said organisers. The session emphasised the need for multidisciplinary innovation and international cooperation to accelerate the uptake of advanced biofuel technologies across Europe and beyond.
